Active Play

Developing large muscle skills is essential for growing children. Their sense of independence, mastery over their environment, and pride is undisguised when they shout, "Watch me climb to the top!" or "Look, I can swing higher than you can." Being outside gives them the space they need for riding wheel toys and bikes and for playing "Chase me" or tag. The confinement of four walls will become a distant memory as they roll down hill, play hide-and-seek, or swim in the lake. An added benefit-they don't have to use their inside voices! For parents, summer is an easier time to place limits on TVs, computers, and electronic games. Replace those activities with these simple pleasures that never go out of style:

- Visit neighborhood parks.
- Plan a weekend camping trip.
- Host a picnic or barbecue.
- Go on a family bike ride.
- Play soccer, basketball, or some other organized sport.
